They will be paid a salary; however, they are responsible for their own round-trip airline fare and fees associated with obtaining their J-1 VISA. On acceptance and arrival to the assigned camp, the applicant will receive a \$150 grant to assist with their visa expenses and a special scholarship to assist with the cost of their travel that varies by region as follows:

From the Americas: \$350
From Europe: \$500

From Asia-Pacific: \$600
From the Africa Continent: \$600
