

NOTICE OF MOTION

TO: The National Scout Council

MOTION: 24/2010

Title: Acquiring and disposal of properties

PROPOSAL:

That the following changes be brought to Policy, Organisation & Rules:

923 Property

- 923.1 All immovable property shall vest in the South African Scout Association and shall be registered in its name.
- 923.2 Immovable property to be acquired or dealt with and falling within the jurisdiction of a Province may only be purchased, sold, hired, let, mortgaged or otherwise acquired or disposed of by the Provincial Chairman acting with the approval of the Provincial Scout Council. **A decision by the Provincial Scout Council in this regard must be submitted, in writing, to the National Finance Committee for approval.**
- 923.3 Immovable property to be acquired or dealt with and not falling within the jurisdiction of a Province may only be purchased, sold, hired, let, mortgaged or otherwise acquired or disposed of by the National Chairman acting with the approval of the National Chairman's Committee.
- 923.4 All proceeds from disposal of fixed assets will be deposited in trust in a designated account (for the benefit of that unit/province) in the Scout Foundation.**
- 923.5 No immovable property may be purchased or improved by the Association on behalf of any Group, LA, Region, Province, or by SAHQ unless fifty per cent of the cost of such purchase or improvement is held in cash or in securities and/or approved guarantees.
- 923.6 All movable property belonging to the Association shall be vested in the National Chairman or his or her deputy and all movable property belonging to any Province, Region, or LA or Group or any branch thereof shall be vested in the Provincial Chairman having jurisdiction over such Provinces.
- 923.7 Should any Province or Region or LA or Group or any branch thereof cease to exist its movable property shall be taken over and dealt with respectively by the National Chairman or the Provincial

Chairman having jurisdiction, or their deputies, as each shall deem best.

923.8 The Association may sue and be sued in its own name.

923.9 Group Committees, LA EXCOs and Scout Councils responsible for the Association's immovable property must adequately insure such property.

MOTIVATION:

There are discrepancies between the policy document: Administration and Finance and the PO&R. It is necessary for the PO&R to be brought into line.
