Title: Scout tape

PROPOSAL

Changes to Rule 801.2

801.2 Scout Tape

All members may wear the official purple name tape, showing the word "SCOUTS South Africa", on the uniform left breast pocket flap or in a similar appropriate position on ladies' uniforms. ~~Warranted Scouters may replace this tape with tapes appropriate to their rank showing the names, Assistant Pack Scouter, Assistant Troop Scouter, Pack Scouter, Troop Scouter, Group Scouter or Commissioner. Unwarranted Scouters acting in these ranks may wear the appropriate coloured shoulder tape. Invested Rovers may replace this tape with a tape reading "ROVERS".~~

MOTIVATION

Correction of PO&R in line with decision made at National Scout Council 2008.

Extract of National Scout Council minutes 2008:

7.23. Motion 34/08: Positioning of badges

Adopted with the proviso that point 1 and point 2 (Southern Zone badge and SA Flag badge) is optional as Cubs have small shirts and cannot fit all the badges on. However if a Scout is representing South Africa they need to wear both these badges.

PO&R be amended to (diagrams are attached to the signed copies of these minutes):

Badges to add to uniform

The following badge needs to be added to the following charts:

1. Southern Zone Badge be placed 3cm above outside edge of the left breast pocket.
2. SA Flag Position .5cm above and centred on the zone badge.
- 3. New SA Logo badge replace the warrant / scout / rover tags on the left pocket flap.**
4. With the new association branding a new national HQ badge needs to be made. (Suggested that a nation competition be run for the members to design the new badge.)
